1. Several bad things happened to Rose in her childhood. What were they? As a result of these, what two gripping emotions kept her in bondage?
2. How did these things affect her life, her progress, her relationships with both God and man?
3. Have you suffered a terrible hardship in your life? If so, think back on the event and remember how you felt. What happened afterward? How do you feel now?
4. Why did Alex yearn to make a good name and fortune for himself?
5. Being rejected by a father is one of the most damaging things that can happen to a child. Sometimes simply having an uninvolved father can be as bad as having an abusive father. Think about your own father and reflect on how he affected you and your perception of yourself. List qualities, bad or good, that you see in yourself as a result of your father.
6. What did Alex come to realize that helped him overcome his earthly father's rejection?
7. Do you believe some people never find their destiny? Do you personally know people who are unfulfilled in life and just going through the motions? Perhaps you feel this way. Why do you think that is?
8. What are some things you believe keep people from their God-planned destiny?
9. Do you believe in miracles? What miracle occurred in Washington D.C. that sent the British packing? In the story, what brought about the miracle?
10. Search the Bible for instances where God used the prayers of normal people to do mighty things. There are hundreds. List as many as you can find and put the list up where you will see it daily to remind you that the prayer of the righteous is powerful and effective!
